

York Anglo Scandinavian Society Winter Walk 2015
Saturday 17th January 2014
Coxwold Country Walk – Hushwaite/Coxwold

Destination: Circular walk between Hushwaite and Coxwold
Distance – 5 miles (8K) a relatively flat route, around field side paths, tracks and parkland, with some on tarmac/farm roads. With good views to the north across to the White Horse and along the valley east wards to Byland Abbey and Ampleforth and westwards towards the Pennine Hills.
Start 11.00

Meet 10.45 High Street Hushwaite (at the eastern end of High Street for road side parking).

Lunch Old School Rooms Tea Rooms Coxwold.

Please note that for those who do not feel that they can manage the full circular walk, that it is possible to do the morning section, have lunch and then get the bus from Coxwold back to Hushwaite or all the way back to York, the bus stops in Coxwold at a garage just round the corner from the tea rooms at 14.13 or 16.23. Or if you only want to do the afternoon section and have lunch with the rest of the group, you can catch the bus in York at 11.05 arriving in Hushwaite at 11.50 and Coxwold at 11.55 – the bus service is run by Stephenson's and is number 31X in both directions, and starts and terminates in Station Avenue, York.
 (Unfortunately, there is only a 9.05 departure from York, getting into Hushwaite at 9.50 almost one hour earlier than required – but one could have a saunter around the village to kill time if you wish to travel by bus).
